WAFA and Work Experience

MAS 401 is the final program offered in the Mountain Adventure School series. 401 offers Wilderness Advanced First Aid (WAFA), a 40-hour industry standard course that trains individuals to deal with incidents in a wilderness environment. 401 also includes work experience credits completed in the outdoor field. The program has been designed to provide students with employable skills and experience for future work in an outdoor recreation or education field.

Raven Medical Wilderness Advanced First Aid (40 hour certification course)

2-week work experience (mentorship with seasoned MAS guides)

A specialized overnight camping trip

Credits offered:

HCS 3020 (1 credit, 4-day WAFA)

HSS 1010 (1 credit, Health Services Foundations, online)

HCS 3000 (1 credit, Workplace Safety Systems, online)

Work Experience (3 credits)

Dates: July 3 – 9, 2024. These dates include an orientation day, the 4-day WAFA, and a camping trip.

The two weeks work experience will be determined through discussion with the MAS Program Coordinator (mas@progressiveacademy.ca).

Fee: \$645.00 (A deposit upon acceptance is required, but full payment is not due until March 31st. Payment plans are also available.)

Note: For those not wishing to participate in the 2 week work experience, the fee is \$960.00.

Fees include: Teachers/Guides/Instructors, certification fees, meals, accommodations, group equipment, and transportation while at camp. Fee does NOT include transportation to and from camp.

Registration will open on January 8th, 2024.
